

Objectives of the Programme

The School of Education, Central University of South Bihar, Gaya is conducting second Faculty Induction Training Programme of thirty days duration under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) Scheme of MHRD as per the recommendations of Group of Secretaries (GoS) on Education and Social Development, Govt. of India. The Programme is designed to train the newly inducted faculty members of Central and State funded Universities/ Institutions of Higher Education/ Colleges or similar kind of Institutions/ Departments as approved by UGC to familiarize them in their roles as freshly inducted faculty member. The Ministry of Human Resource Development has proposed this programme with a view to improve the quality of newly inducted faculty members in Higher Education Institutions. This programme is designed as a platform for them to interact with experts and share their day-to-day experiences on addressing various issues that they encounter in their setups. It will orient newly appointed faculty members on various generic aspects of teaching-learning, assessment and evaluation techniques and practices, instructional methodologies, ICT enabled teaching learning and equip them with knowledge of university rules and regulations and basics of governance and administration systems of universities and colleges.



Transportation Modes to Central University of South Bihar, Gaya

Gaya is well connected to the rest of India and the world by roadways, railways and airways. The Central University of South Bihar Campus is around 12 Kilometers from Gaya city.

Roadways

The Grand Trunk Road is about 30 km. from Gaya city. Thus, Gaya is well connected to Kolkata, Varanasi, Allahabad, Kanpur, Delhi and Amritsar. A national highway (NH-83) connects Gaya to Patna.

Railways

Gaya railway station is the second most important station in Bihar after Patna railway station. It is a junction and is well connected to the four important metropolitan cities i.e. New Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai and Mumbai through important Broad Gauge Routes. In addition to various rajdhani express and other trains, there is an exclusive daily train, the Mahabodhi Express, from New Delhi to Gaya. It takes around 11-15 hours to reach Gaya from New Delhi by train. There are large number of direct trains from important stations in India like Ranchi, Varanasi, Lucknow, Kanpur, Allahabad, Agra, Mathura, Jabalpur, Bhopal, Indore, Nagpur, Bhubaneswar, Puri, etc. to Gaya. There is frequent railway service between Gaya and Patna, the two important cities of Bihar. Central University of South Bihar campus is around 12 kilometers from Gaya railway station.

Airways

Gaya has a big international airport. Gaya airport is served by Air India for domestic flights and Sri Lankan Airlines, Mihin Lanka, Druk Air and other international airlines for international flights. The distance between Gaya airport and Central University of South Bihar campus is around 20 kilometers.

School of Education, CUSB

The School of Education of the University was established in 2013-14 by launching four-year integrated programmes in the two streams viz. B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. Further, to cater to the demand of quality teacher educators and researchers in the field of education, the school has started M.Ed. and Ph.D. (Education) programmes.

Centres of PMMMNTT Scheme at School of Education, CUSB

School of Education, CUSB is running two centres (Centre for Learning and Pedagogic Studies and Centre for Assessment and Evaluation) under the scheme of PMMMNTT since September, 2016. School of Education has been conducting number of programmes/activities under these two centres since their inception.

Accommodation, Travelling and Registration Fee

Accommodation and TA (up to AC III only) to the outstation participants will be provided as per the University norms. No registration fee shall be charged from the participants.

Eligibility

- Newly recruited faculty members in the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer or in similar kind of positions of Indian Universities/ Colleges/ Institutions. However, following faculty members will be given preference:
- *The faculty members from the organizations approved under 2(f)/12(b) by the UGC or from deemed to be Universities.*
- *The faculty members within four years from the date of their joining in the present post.*
- *The faculty members requiring an orientation course for their career advancement.*

Registration Process

The scanned copy of filled in registration form should reach to the programme coordinator via email on or before 20th May 2019. Since seats are limited the selection of the participants will be decided by a committee. Submission of original filled in and duly forwarded registration form along with the relieving certificate is mandatory at the time of joining the programme.
