

**NOTIFICATION**

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the University Admission Teaching & Evaluation Committee (UATEC) of Central University of South Bihar in its meeting held on 25.11.2020 has taken the following decisions with regard to the physical re-opening of the University for students in the light of 'UGC guidelines for Re-opening the Universities and Colleges Post Lockdown due to COVID-19 Pandemic' issued vide D.O.14-8/2020 (CPP-II) dated 05.11.2020:

- (i) The physical re-opening of the campus for the students of lab based programmes shall be made in a phased manner w.e.f. 01.12.2020.
- (ii) It has been decided to conduct practical classes and theory classes (if required) of the students of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of the following Postgraduate programmes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2020:
  - a. M.Sc. Environmental Science
  - b. M.Sc. Life Science
  - c. M.Sc. Biotechnology
  - d. M.Sc. Bioinformatics
  - e. M.Sc. Physics
  - f. M.Sc. Chemistry
  - g. M.Sc. Statistics
  - h. M.S. Economics
- (iii) The end-term examination of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of above mentioned PG Programmes shall be conducted in usual (offline) mode from 5<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.
- (iii) All 3<sup>rd</sup> semester students enrolled in above mentioned Eight (08) Postgraduate Programmes are directed to attend classes as per time-table to be notified by their respective departments w.e.f. 01.12.2020.
- (iv) All 3<sup>rd</sup> semester students enrolled in above mentioned Eight (08) Postgraduate Programmes shall be mandatorily required to reside in University's hostel during their stay in order to attend classes as well as for appearing in the end-term examinations. During their stay from 01.12.2020 to 13.01.2021, they shall not be allowed to visit outside the campus. Hence, they should carry all necessary belongings required to stay for the period of one and half months.
- (v) The students shall be required to make payment on pro-rata basis towards fooding-lodging during their stay in the University's hostel. As per existing applicable fees for accommodation in hostel and mess charges a student shall have to pay @ Rs.2250/- towards hostel fee and @ Rs. 3800/- towards mess charges for one and half month period.

- (vi) All the students during their stay in the campus shall adhere with the safety measure for containment on COVID-19 as defined in UGC guidelines for Re-opening the Universities and Colleges Post Lockdown due to COVID-19 Pandemic' issued vide D.O.14-8/2020 (CPP-II) dated 05.11.2020.
