

The Central University of South Bihar secured 22nd position among the India's Best Government Universities in the ranking carried out by India Today.

New Academic Programmes:

The University has introduced five new Postgraduate (PG) programmes in subjects namely, Chemistry, Physics, Social Work, M.Com and History during the academic year 2018-19 under Department of Chemistry, Department of Physics, Department of Sociological Studies, Department of Commerce & Business Studies and Department of Historical Studies & Archaeology respectively.

Students' Enrolment:

Admissions in various programmes are made through CUCET, a national level combined entrance test that was organised by 10 Central Universities jointly. The Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET) - 2018 was conducted throughout India at 86 test centres for admission in various Undergraduate (UG), Postgraduate (PG) and Ph.D. programmes offered under different disciplines for academic year 2018-19. Entrance Test was held on 28-29 April, 2018. On the basis of score of Entrance Test and merit, total 777 candidates had taken admission in UG, PG and Ph.D. courses offered by Central University of South Bihar.

New Appointments / Promotions:

- > Teaching positions Altogether 37 faculty members purely on temporary basis were appointed in different Departments during the period. Out of 37, 03 faculty members (temporary) left the University during the period.
- Non-Teaching positions 11 Non-teaching employee have been appointed on regular basis and 08 non-teaching staff have been promoted and 08 non-teaching staff have left during the period. Hence, the total strength of non-teaching positions reaches to 111.

Grant-in-Aid:

The University has received a sum of Rs. 55.38 Crores under General Development Assistance, Rs. 53.32 Crores unspent balance of Previous year and Receipt from tuition fee & other Incomes amounting to RS. 7.54 Crores utilized a sum of Rs. 90.58 crores during the year 2018 - 19.





CUSB at a Glance



About the University

The Central University of South Bihar is established under the Central Universities Act, 2009 (section 25 of 2009) as Central University of Bihar (name changed under the Central Universities Amendment Act, 2014). The University is functioning from the 300 acres sprawling campus at Panchanpur, about 15kms. from Gaya railway station, on Gaya — Panchanpur Road. The University welcomes all with a grand Entrance Plaza and further provides visual delight with a half-globe shaped Stupa and a magnificent multi-storied Administrative Block building. Besides, the Schools buildings named as Science building, Social Science building, Education building, lecture hall complex, two hostels one each for boys and girls, one guest house altogether are like visual treat for visitors, and offering a pristine environs for running academic and co-curricular activities. Along with world-class highly qualified faculty members, high teacher-student ratio, baskets full of elective courses in different programmes, the University offers Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with total internal evaluation of students' performance at Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) levels. Other highlights of CUSB includes a conducive and research oriented environment with multi-disciplinary approach, innovative pedagogies, promising infrastructural facilities and effective students' support system to nurture students' personality in a holistic manner and to prepare them for bright future.

Objective of the University (As stated in Section 5 of the Act)

- > To disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit
- To make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences, and technology in its educational programmes
- > To take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning process and inter disciplinary studies and research
- To educate and train manpower for the development of the country
- To establish linkages with industries for the promotion of science and technology
- To pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.

Vision of the University

The Collective reasoning of this University is committed for a better tomorrow and we strive together to create an eco-system where best minds holding high human and moral values interact to constantly chase perfection in frontline research and teaching to provide younger generations a platform for realizing their potentials to serve humanity with compassion.




Facilities at the University

With infrastructure at nascent stage of its development and handful of buildings, the University puts it best efforts to offer a passable atmosphere for learning and research activities to the students and faculty members. The well-stacked library, computer centres with contemporary facilities like Wi-Fi, state-of-the-art laboratories with delicate to heavy equipments, smart class rooms, conference rooms, etc. altogether makes the University a perfect abode for academia, which impresses the outside world a lot and helps in earning plaudits in the form of ranking carried out by different agencies of the country.

Central Computing Facility

The facility is offered to faculty members and staff with sufficient numbers of desktops / laptops attached with printer / Xerox facilities at almost all work desks. Computer Laboratory provides a central computing facility to the faculty members as well as students for their assignments, projects, dissertation and research related works. In computer lab, printing and scanning facilities is available. Teachers are also provided with individual desktop / laptop with pool printer to assist them in preparing for their lectures and take up their research pursuits. All computers are equipped with latest and legal operating system and application software to cater to the academic needs. Computers are protected by firewall and reliable antivirus software against computer virus, malware and unauthorized access. Internet facility



through LAN as well as Wi-Fi connectivity is provided to departments /centres, library, class rooms, administrative building and other sections. A fully functional Website of the university has been developed. It is maintained and updated regularly. The University has powerful E-mail system with group mail IDs of students, faculty members and staff.

Central Library

The University has a well-equipped Central Library with good collection of Title of latest edition of books in sufficient volumes, standard national and international journals. The library has more than 25,000 books to support academic curricula, teaching & research in various science and social science subjects. All the books are barcoded and organized on shelves using Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) scheme. The library subscribes to 117 print journals and magazines. The library is stocked with 444 bound volumes of journals and 100 project reports and more than 8200 full text electronic (e) journals from renowned publishers. Library services include circulation (issue/return) of books, Inter-Library Loan through DELNET, New Delhi, Current Awareness Service (CAS) for books and journals, photocopy,



etc. Users can search the availability of books in library using OPAC, current status of books, due date of return, reserve/hold book, etc. Access to electronic resources is available for students, faculty and officials on their computer within the university premises. Recently, access to these resources has been extended through Virtual Private Network (VPN). 24 x 7 reference service is also being provided through CUSB Virtual Reference Platform. The library is open from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on all working days and Saturdays.



Laboratories

Most of the departments have its own laboratory equipped with equipment and latest instruments for conducting practical for students and research scholars. The departments of Biotechnology, Life Science, Environmental Science, Physics, Chemistry, Mass Communication, etc. have well — furnished laboratories.

Health Centre / Medical Facility

The University has its Health Centre, which provides primary level treatment to faculty, staff and students for general ailments under the supervision of Medical officer.

Psychological Counselling Service

Like physical health, mental health determines efficiency and productivity, which is critically important for teaching-learning process, creativity, and congenial environment in academic institutions. The University adopts a forward looking approach and institutes psychological counselling and guidance for students, faculty and employees under the supervision of expert time-to-time or on need basis.

Specific Facilities for Students

The University believes that the students are future of the country and they deserve extra care to pursue their studies without any hassle. The University is committed to offer the best possible amenities to students so that they can study and carry research work with complete peace of mind for a better outcome. Some of the facilities specifically provided to students are mentioned further under different headings.

Semester System: The system is followed in all Academic programmes (courses) of the University to enhance the curricular space and encourage the accelerated learning opportunities.

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS): This system facilitates the students to have vertical integration of knowledge and holistic development.

Evaluation System: Continuous internal evaluation is carried out in the University by the faculty members to assess the performance of the students. The University has developed appropriate mechanism to ensure transparency and accountability in the internal assessments and End-Semester evaluations.

Governance: The University is following a decentralised and participative system of governance to achieve the mandate stated in the Act and Statues. Faculty members are directly involved in decision-making bodies of the University, which in turn helps the students in a great way for redressal of their grievances. Each department of the University has a Departmental Committee and it takes the decisions for academic proposals at initial state before being placed before Apex decision-making bodies of the University. The Board of Studies (BOS) is also an important body of the department which specifically looks after the curriculum development work. Also, the University has put it efforts towards the use of E-Governance tools to bring effectiveness into its administration to promote transparency and efficiency in the system.



CUCET: The Admission to various programmes (courses) of the University is made through national level entrance test jointly conducted by 14 Central Universities and named as Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET). With its transparent and national level admission process, the University has succeeded to attract the students from different states and maintaining the diversity and national character efficiently.

Scholarship Schemes: All research scholars (Ph.D.) students get UGC scholarship. In addition to Central government and state government funded scholarships, the University offers a number of scholarship schemes to deserving and needy students, namely (i) Merit Scholarship to CUSBET/Semester Toppers (ii) Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (iii) Earn While You Learn (EWYL) Scheme & (iv) Attendance Based Merit Scholarship.

Hostels for Accommodation: Presently the University offers accommodation to students with one (1) Boys Hostel and one (1) Girls Hostel having combined capacity to accommodate around 800 students. Mess facility is also available for students residing in the hostels on payment basis.

Vidyarthi Mediclaim Policy: All the students of the University are insured under this scheme. This is a unique policy of National Insurance Company (NIC) designed to provide health and personal accident cover to the students. Under this scheme the students are eligible for cashless treatment in authorized hospitals as well as for reimbursement of cost of treatment in other hospitals within the limit of Rs. 50,000.



Campus Placement: The University has a Career Counselling and Placement Cell which takes care of the campus placements and job opportunities for the students. Many students got job placement during the session 2018 — 19 in organisations like Azim Premji Foundation, Care India (NGO), Gandhi Fellowship - Piramal Foundation, etc. Students from Media department got placements in Times of India, Hindustan Times, ETV Bharat, Hindustan Dainik and Prabhat Khabar and along with many other organisations.

Internships: Keeping in view the importance of role of practice based learning / first-hand industry experience the University makes arrangements for internship opportunities to the students during Summer vacation.

Sports & Cultural / Co-curricular Activities: The University has committees like Games and Sports Activities Committee, Cultural Activities Committee which conducts various activities for students round the year. The students of the University participate in the state and nation level competitions and events under the supervision of co-ordinators of the committees and impress all with their brilliant performances.

Quality Management: The University is having an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to ensure progressive improvement in efficiency of the functioning of the institution.

Proctorial Board: The board is responsible to maintain discipline among the students of University and it functions under supervision of the Chief Proctor. The Proctorial board takes preventive steps to maintain the discipline within the University premises, issues the notices and warnings as per need of the situation.

Student Welfare Board: The Dean Students' Welfare (DSW) is shouldering the responsibility of looking after the general welfare of students outside classrooms, in order to ensure all round development. The office of DSW also performs the duties and functions viz. (i) make arrangements for educational tours, excursions and participation in sports activities outside the University (ii) conduct social and cultural activities (iii) form of student bodies (iv) evaluate student — teacher relationship (v) examine and recommend for financial aid to needy students and concession for travel, and other facilities (vi) facilitate fellowships / scholarships for further studies in the country or abroad (vii) student counselling (viii) provide special assistance (if required) to differently abled students or women students (ix) provide Student information services (x) organise alumni association (xii) issue certificates as authorised and delegated by the Vice-Chancellor.



work done on a new class of nanomaterials, namely, 'hollow silver nanocubes' under the supervision of Dr. Amiya Priyam, Assistant Professor, Chemistry was presented at the prestigious meeting, Faraday Discussion, which was held at London, UK during February 18-20, 2019. The international scientific event was organised by Royal Society of Chemistry (RSC), Cambridge, UK and the theme for the discussion was "Hot-electron science and microscopic processes in plasmonics and catalysis". The team of CUSB synthesized a new class of nanomaterials called 'hollow silver nanocubes' which show unique optical property, 'Surface Plasmon Resonance'. These nanomaterials were then utilized to harvest solar energy for environmental remediation of dyewastes produced in textile industry.

Cultural Tour under "Ek Bharat, Shreshta Bharat" scheme to Tripura University


