The process of recruitment shall be carried out in two stages:

Stage-1: Shortlisting of candidates on the basis of Screening Test consisting of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)

Stage-2: Interview (50 Marks) to assess his/her suitability for the post.

- 1. The question paper for Screening Test would be bilingual (Hindi and English) and the candidate will have the option to respond in either of the language.
- 2. Each question of screening test carries one mark. There shall be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.
- 3. Maximum 15 candidates shall be shortlisted for appearing in interview for each post in order of merit based on the marks obtained by them in Screening Test. However, in case of tie at cut-off marks, all such tied candidates shall be called for Interview over and above the maximum number of candidate as specified (i.e. 15).
- 4. The final merit shall be drawn based on combined marks of Screening Test (100 marks) and Interview (50 marks). However, merit shall be drawn for only those candidates who have appeared in both stages i.e. Stage-I (Screening Test) and Stage-2 (Interview).

The process of recruitment shall be carried out in two stages:

Stage-1: Shortlisting of candidates on the basis of Screening Test consisting of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)

- 1. The question paper for Screening Test would be bilingual (Hindi and English) and the candidate will have the option to respond in either of the language.
- 2. Each question of screening test carries one mark.
- 3. Maximum 15 candidates shall be shortlisted for appearing in interview in order of the marks obtained by them in Screening Test. However, in case of tie at cut-off marks, all such tied candidates shall be called for Interview over and above the maximum number of candidate as specified (i.e. 15).
- 4. The final merit shall be drawn based on combined marks of Screening Test (50 marks) and Interview (50 marks). However, merit shall be drawn for only those candidates who have appeared in both stages i.e. Stage-I (Screening Test) and Stage-2 (Interview).
