- 4) The proposed CBCS based syllabus was also placed before the BoS members for their suggestions.
- 5) Members of BoS thoroughly reviewed the proposed syllabus, provided inputs wherever needed.
- 6) All members approved the proposed overall structure of the M. Sc. Life Science syllabus.
- 7) The total no. of credits as 96 was unanimously agreed by the BoS members. The BoS external expert stated that the proposed syllabus with 96 credits is designed as per the UGC guidelines for CBCS framework.
- 8) All the suggestion proposed by the members were discussed and incorporated in the proposed syllabus.
- 9) The syllabus will be implemented from 2018 onwards.
- 10) For the project dissertation, BoS members suggested that the students shall be allotted to faculty members by recommendations of DC to avoid any kind of biasness. In case of any discrepancy, the decision will be taken by the Head.


The meeting ended with vote of the thanks to all external and internal members for all the hard work and attending the meeting.
